


# 1 STAR CREEK FALLS

**Location:** Crowsnest Pass (Coleman)

Accessibility: From the parking area in Coleman, hike the newly completed 2 km loop around Star Creek falls.

**Description:** This family-friendly trail takes visitors on a loop, complete with wayfaring signage to guide the way. Be sure to follow the trail markers to stay on the best route, leading you to stunning views of Star Creek Falls and Crowsnest Mountain.





## 2 LUNDBRECK FALLS

**Location:** Lundbreck Falls Provincial Recreation Area (Hwy3)

Accessibility: Lundbreck Falls can be seen in all their glory from an easily accessible viewpoint, on Hwy 3. Visitors can camp, or park at the day use area of Lundbreck Falls Provincial Recreation Area and take a short trail to the falls.

**Description:** One of the most iconic waterfalls in the South Canadian Rockies, Lundbreck Falls is a powerful force of nature that is photo worthy in every season.







### **CASTLE FALLS**

**Location:** Castle Falls Campground in Castle Provincial Park

Accessibility: Access the falls via the campground, either as a registered guest or through the day use area. The falls are a short and easy walk from the parking area.

**Description:** Stunning crystal clear water, with plenty of natural rock seating. Castle Falls is the perfect place for a picnic and a must see in Castle Provincial Park.



## 4 CAMERON FALLS

**Location:** Waterton Lakes National Park

**Accessibility:** Drive right up to the falls in Waterton Townsite, or walk up the short paved path and stand on the viewing bridge.

**Description:** One of Waterton's most famous and photographed spots! Cameron Falls is a must-see landmark in Waterton, with plenty of parking and easy accessibility.
